We also increased our efforts from the previous year by expanding the Fill-A-Bag program into Gresham. The program was hugely successful, thanks to the support of the Wood Village Branch and Gresham community partners, including Gresham Ford, Boeing and the *Gresham Outlook*.

## Program Details

**Walk & Knock:** The annual one day food collection event that provides one third of all Clark County food bank donations. Watch for distribution of grocery collection bags this November in the *Columbian* newspaper. Volunteers will collect donations on Sat., Dec. 3rd. You can also drop off donations at any Riverview location.

**Fill-A-Bag:** A grassroots effort initiated by Riverview in partnership with local newspapers and retailers in Aumsville, Stevenson, White Salmon, Goldendale and Gresham. Local newspapers distribute grocery bags to households throughout these areas and donations can be dropped off at Riverview branches.

25 percent of households receiving emergency food had at least one working member.

Households with children are the largest group served. Children who are hungry have more difficulty learning in school and have a higher risk for health problems later in life.
